



Uploading To GRASP Results to CHART On-line

What Is It?

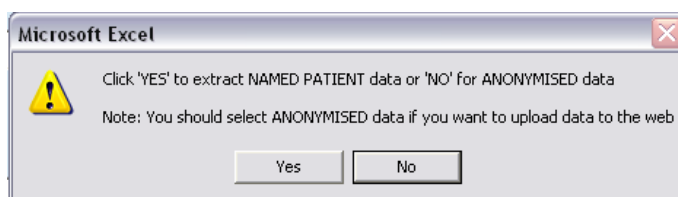
CHART On-Line is a way for practices to anonymously compare their GRASP-AF data with other practices in their PCT, Cardiac Network area, SHA or nationally.

It also allows certain staff external to the practice (Other practices, PCT staff, Cardiac Network support staff, NHS Heart Improvement staff) to view the results, although the practice who has uploaded the data cannot be identified by these staff – practice name / national code not present.

Before Starting

You must have run the GRASP-AF queries, having chosen to have anonymous data when asked at the beginning of the process.

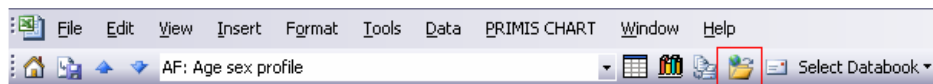
If you followed the guidance in “Running GRASP-AF Part 1 - All Systems” you should have run both sets of query files to get anonymous and named patient data.



Instructions

Should take no more than 1 minute to upload to CHART On-Line, provided actions specified in “Before Starting” have been completed

1. Open CHART
2. Click on “3. Click here to view new results”
3. Double-click on “Report on patients with AF (Pseudonymised)”
4. Allow it to load and get the Dashboard view
5. Click on the “Upload Data to Web...” button, found along the top of the screen (see right)



6. When the window appears choose “Close this box to continue”
7. Click “Yes” when the box headed “Web transmission message: Authorisation to send data to PRIMIS appears”
8. Enter your PRIMIS user name and password (needed to log into the PRIMIS Profile Centre) and press “OK”
9. When the confirmation message appears press “OK”
